Rules of Grizzly Island Wildlife Area

1. Overnight camping allowed only in trailers, motorhomes, or campers and at the test site only. No hook-ups available.
2. Parking is allowed only at the check station. No roadside parking.
3. All dog feces and waste must be removed from the parking area.
4. Only gas barbeques are permitted. Barbeques using briquettes are prohibited.
5. Only non-toxic shot may be used. Possession of lead shot in the field is prohibited.

OTHER IMPORTANT NOTICES

Water is limited so be sure to bring enough water for you and your dogs.

All handlers and anyone else in the field must wear blaze orange.

EVERYONE MUST REGISTER AT THE RANGER STATION

The location is indicated on the enclosed map.
A daily fee must be paid if you are over 15 and do not have a valid California hunting or fishing license or an annual wildlife pass. You may purchase a wildlife pass from Fish & Game or from any hunting or fishing license vendor.

ALL ENTRANTS MUST CHECK IN WITH THE HUNT TEST SECRETARY IMMEDIATELY UPON ARRIVAL.

All entrants and spectators who enter the Hunt Test grounds must fill out and sign the enclosed liability statement. Additional copies will be available on the GCESF website and from the Secretary at the Test. No dog whose owners or handlers are present will be allowed to run until this statement is complete and in the hands of the Hunt Test Secretary.

**GOLD COUNTRY ENGLISH SETTER FANCIERS
AGREEMENT FOR ASSUMPTION OF RISK,
INDEMNITY, AND RELEASE FROM LIABILITY**

1. I, _____, acknowledge that I have voluntarily applied to Gold Country English Setter Fanciers (GCESF) to participate in hunting test activities ("field events") sponsored by GCESF, its officers and members, to be held at Grizzly Island Wildlife Area, Suisun, California.

2. ASSUMPTION OF RISK: I am aware that field events are a hazardous activity and involve inherent risks and dangers, which could cause serious injury or death, including the following risks: the discharge by gunners and others of firearms with live ammunition; the presence of wild game either as the object of the trial or indigenous to the trial grounds; the use and presence of horses and dogs of unknown temperaments, degrees of training and control by their respective owners and handlers; and the use of motor vehicles on and off the field event grounds by various persons (and who may or may not have liability insurance). I understand that these risks and others not specifically enumerated herein exist both during the actual field event and at other times before and after the event while the grounds are occupied by GCESF for purposes of conducting the field event over a period of one or more days to its conclusion. I am voluntarily participating in these activities with knowledge of the dangers involved, I hereby accept any and all risks of injury or death, and I verify my understanding and intent to do so by placing my initials here:_____.

3. RELEASE: As consideration for being permitted by GCESF, its officers and members, to participate in these field event activities and use their facilities, I hereby agree that I, my assignees, heirs, beneficiaries, guardians, and legal representatives will not make a claim against, sue or attach the property of GCESF, or any of its officers or members, or any of GCESF's agents and employees such as judges, marshals, and gunners, or the owner or supplier of any of the horses, vehicles and equipment used in these activities, for injury or damage resulting from negligence of any officer, member, employee, agent, or contractor of GCESF, arising out of my participation in the field event or my presence at the field event grounds. I hereby release GCESF, its officers, members, employees, agents, and contractors from all actions, claims, or demands that I, my assignees, heirs, beneficiaries, guardians, and legal representatives now have or may in the future have for injury or damage arising from my participation in the field event for my presence at the field event grounds. INDEMNITY: I further agree for myself, my assignees, heirs, beneficiaries, guardians and legal representatives to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless GCESF, its officers, members, employees, agents and contractors from any and all losses, claims, actions or proceedings of any kind which may be initiated by myself and/or any other person or organization arising out of my participating in the field event or presence at the field event grounds, including but not necessarily limited to any actions of suits for personal injuries, death, or property damage. This includes reimbursement of all legal cost and attorneys' fees incurred by GCESF and the other indemnified parties, or any of them, for the defense of any such actions or cross-actions. This obligation to defend and indemnify GCESF and the other indemnified parties applies even if GCESF, and or its officers, members, employees, agents and contractors, negligently contributed to the occurrence causing the personal injuries, death or property damage.
