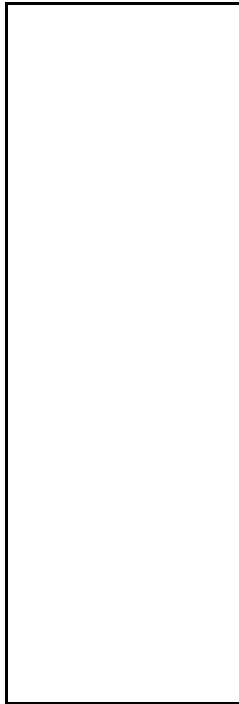

Each first entry of a dog includes a \$50 AKC Recording Fee. In addition, each entry of a dog in recordable, single-entry classes includes \$3.00 Event Service Fee. These fees are required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test and are collected by the show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). First Rally entry of a dog includes \$3.50 AKC Recording Fee and \$3.00 on each additional Rally entry same dog. These fees are already included in the fee schedule listed above.

The **LOADING ZONE** is for 20 minutes only and violators will be towed.

Handicapped parking is available and typically provides an appropriate surface to the facilities. It is not necessarily closer to the buildings or the rings.

PARKING SPACES WILL BE PRE-ASSIGNED. PEOPLE WISHING TO PARK TOGETHER MUST SEND IN THEIR RESERVATIONS TOGETHER; however there is no guarantee that we can accommodate all requests.

COST: \$80.00 PER SPACE FOR BOTH FRIDAY & SATURDAY NIGHTS. ONE NIGHT NOT AVAILABLE. Spaces are 22' x 40'. Vehicles over 40' total length or vehicles with a slide out that will not fit in a 20' x 40' space will need to buy 2 spaces. If your entire package will not fit in a 22' x 40' space, you will need to buy additional space. Trailers and tow units may be required to be unhitched. Notice To Exhibitors

1. Conditional, telegraph, telephone, and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms or photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. Entries without fees are not acceptable. Fees must accompany entries. Post dated checks and returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Club will add a collection fee of \$20.00 to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor(s) may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.
2. **PLEASE TYPEWRITE or NEATLY PRINT** all entries. Use black or blue ink as entries will be photocopied. DO NOT use pencil or colored ink to write entries.
3. Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Changes are not acceptable by telephone. Email or faxed changes are allowed.
4. ERRORS ON ENTRY FORMS — Owners alone are responsible for the correctness of entries, or for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class in which the dog is ineligible to compete, regardless of who makes such errors. No entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date and time. Due to cost of processing, no refunds less than \$4.00 will be made.
5. ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED in event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event's Show Committee. If, because of riots, wars, civil disturbances, fire, Act of God, strikes, national emergencies, health emergencies, extreme weather conditions (including but not limited to extreme heat, floods, hurricanes, lightning, or earthquakes), or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors, and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fees will be made.
6. **CONFIRMATION OF ENTRY & SCHEDULE OF JUDGING TIME** will be sent to the address on the Official AKC entry form after the closing date. The schedule will also be emailed electronically if an email address is included on the entry form. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the Schedule within seven days of the show, please contact the Show Secretary.
7. DECLINATION OF ENTRIES: The Club may decline any entry for cause, and may refuse to receive, or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Club or any official thereof.
8. **PLEASE NOTE:** Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary one half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at the show. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Sec 6)
9. **DOGS MAY ARRIVE** any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.
10. **DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING.** The Club and/or its Show Secretary will not be responsible for, and are not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. Owners or their agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class.
11. **ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ELIGIBLE** to be shown under The American Kennel Club Rules shall be allowed within the show precincts. Dogs under 6 months may not be within the show precincts.
12. **There will be NO DRILLING** nor intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises.
13. All dogs shall be kept on leash or confined, except when being judged or in the exercising ring.
14. **ALL AWARDS WILL BE MADE** in the judging ring to the person exhibiting the dog and that person shall be considered the owner or the agent. All claims for trophies must be made in the judging ring before the completion of judging, and the Show Secretary should be advised at once of any discrepancy. The show-giving club and its officials disclaim any liability for any awards not claimed on the day of the show. The Club will take every precaution for the safety of dogs exhibited, but it is understood that the Gold Country English Setter Fanciers will not be responsible for loss.
15. **THE WELFARE OF AN EXHIBITOR'S CHILD** is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. Please secure proper crates or means to confine dogs for the welfare of all concerned.
16. **OBEDIENCE AND RALLY CLASS TRANSFERS (MOVE-UPS) ARE NOT ALLOWED.**

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, and communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
